COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course will include an overview of the biblical teaching on man and woman, including the uniqueness of their roles in the home and church as well as an exploration of the practical components of being a Christian woman in ministry and leadership in today's church. Various methods for leading will be explored, including large-group ministries and one-to-one mentoring, with examples provided from biblical, historical, and contemporary women in ministry and leadership.
